Winter Boots for Orphans

Children’s Emergency Relief International (CERI) will give 10,000 pairs of winter boots to impoverished children in Moldova this December. CERI is cooperating with the Moldovan government to find the poorest children who formerly lived in orphanages. Six teams will distribute winter boots to children. You can help by volunteering or donating to help purchase boots. Volunteers can travel one of 2 weeks starting December 1-17. One pair of boots costs \$25, which includes shipping, storage, and delivery.
